

The Pacific Gallery and Permanent Collections

We proudly host works of art by accomplished and emerging visionary talent from across Canada and the world. The Pacific Gallery is curated in partnership with the Equinox Gallery and Westbank, featuring rotating exhibitions on a quarterly basis each worthy of a visit. Most recently The Pacific Gallery displayed 'In The Moment' – a photography collection by awardwinning architectural photojournalist Ema Peter. Other past collections have included the works of Douglas Coupland, Adad Hannah, Angela Grossmann, and Paying Attention which featured the works of Berenice Abbott, William Eggleston, Walker Evans, Fred Herzog, Geoffrey James, Vivian Maier and George Tice.

Additionally, the Fairmont Pacific Rim has its own permanent artistic fixtures that have become synonymous with our commitment to creativity and love of art. Under the direction of owners and developers

Westbank and the Peterson Group, the permanent collection which is seen throughout the lobby, hotel and exterior, is driven by eclectic taste and interest. The unmissable pieces include Liam Gillick's outdoor installation of a continuous thread of words forming the sentence "lying on top of a building the clouds looked no nearer than when I was lying on the street." repeated across the balconies on floors 5 to 22 of our 48-storey structure.

Outside visitors can also see Bocci's 16.755, the striking tree-like installation that rises out of a landscape of burnt wood planks; it features 755 lit glass leaves and towers up to 6 metres high.

Inside guests will find James Cheng's 'North Shore Mountains' photograph that spans the grand staircase from floors 2 to 3. This iconic image inspired the exterior stainless steel forest screen on the hotel's facade.

The Lobby Lounge

Vancouver's centre stage for creativity, The Lobby Lounge is a transformative space that reinvents itself with each new collaboration. From brand takeovers, creative partnerships or momentous calendar celebrations like the festive holiday season, or the upcoming 2024 Lunar New Year, which will feature a Dim Sum pop-up in collaboration with Mott 32. In between the ever-changing landscape of the space, The Lobby Lounge becomes home to musical guests and a variety of appearances like illusionists, dancers or fashion shows.






Willow Stream Spa



Guests can retreat to the master bedroom, hosting a fireplace, ensuite marble bathroom with its hand-carved soaker tub, lounge and dining room, den, with an additional kitchen and butler's pantry. Signalling a testament to fine detail and craftsmanship, our 8-foot Swarovski crystal chandelier cascades down two stories cementing its place as a memorable statement piece.

From the second level the private rooftop patio delivers more views that will steal guests' breath, while the gazebo, meditation pond and fire pit will fill their hearts.
