





#### (a) THE WATER OF LIFE





## (10) TEQUILA

The product of Blue Weber Agave is permitted to be produced in five provinces in Mexico. Tequila in its unaged (blanco) state is clean and herbaceous. Once briefly rested in oak (reposado) sharp edges are softened and some oak character is taken on. If fully aged in oak (añejo), tequila exhibits caramel, vanilla, and other oak-driven aromas.
